MH370 OPERATIONAL SEARCH UPDATE #17 Period: 14 MAY 2018 – 20 MAY 2018

DATED 22 MAY 2018

This operational search report has been developed to provide regular updates on the progress of the current search efforts to locate MH370. Please be assured that work is continuing and is aimed at finding MH370.

Background Information

On 10 January 2018, the Government of Malaysia entered an Agreement for the search of MH370 with Ocean Infinity Limited (OI). Currently OI is utilizing their vessel *Seabed Constructor* to survey the search area.

Underwater Search





Site 4, highlighted in red, indicates the area currently being surveyed.


Key Developments

- All available AUVs were launched for the search operation.
- Seabed Constructor has completed surveying Site 1 / Areas 01, 02 & 03, Site 2 / Areas 01, 02 & 03 and Site 3 / Areas 01 & 02 (grey shaded areas) depicted in diagram 2. They are currently surveying Site 4 (red shaded area) depicted in diagram 1 and diagram 3.



• Total area covered as of 20 May 2018 within *Site 1, Site 2 and Site 3* is 88,200 square kilometres and 8,000 square kilometres within *Site 4*.
